

THE GOSPEL THIS SUNDAY

Most of the year we look at the life of our Blessed Lord whilst he lived amongst us on this earth. In a way we look back to the past and keep alive what Jesus did and said and then try to apply it to our present. In today's feast of the Ascension there is something different. Here our attention is drawn not to something Jesus did but to where the Lord Jesus is now. Having risen from the dead he is no longer living in his bodily form here but has ascended to the right hand of the Father. Our Lord did not leave his body here on earth, but his risen and glorified body is in heaven. This fact reminds us of our final goal too - the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. This is the destiny of all believers. This is what God has prepared for those who leave their old life and follow him in that new life which begins in baptism. What defines us as human beings is not the depths to which we can sink - we know this all too well - but the heights to which we are called to rise. Where Christ our head has gone away we his body follow. God bless you this week, Fr Bruno.
