

### **HOLY WEEK**

With Palm Sunday we enter once more into that week made forever holy by what Jesus did for us. We join with Christians throughout the world to recall those events again. We stand, listen and kneel in prayer and awe at the extent of God's real love for us shown in the Cross. In the garden of Gethsemane just before his arrest Jesus prayed. There he asked his disciples to keep awake and pray. It mattered to him that they were with him, that he was not alone. In a mysterious way when we go to the holy week liturgies of the Church what we call to mind is made present and we are there with Jesus. For me it was not until I went to seminary that I experienced the liturgies of Holy Week, the *Triduum*. I invite those of you who also may not have attended these liturgies before to come for the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday evening, the Good Friday solemn celebration of the Lord's Passion and the Easter Vigil as night falls on Holy Saturday. They are moments of grace where we too can watch and pray close to our blessed Lord and Redeemer, Jesus Christ. God bless you this week, Fr Bruno.

#### HELP IN PREPARING FOR CONFESSION

It can be difficult returning to the Sacrament of Reconciliation / Confession if we have not been for a while. The important thing though is returning. In this Sacrament it is not primarily about what we do but what the Lord does. Our sins, our many sins are forgiven. We are at peace with God, our neighbor and ourselves, and grace is given to us. When you go into the confessional you kneel or sit and when the priest makes the sign of the Cross do likewise. Then you say: "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been x years / months since my last confession. These are my sins." Then with sorrow and simplicity say your sins. The priest may say a few words, gives you a penance to do (often a prayer) and invites you to say an act of contrition e.g. "Lord, be merciful to me a sinner" or a longer one such as this: 'Forgive me my sins, O Lord, forgive me my sins; the sins of my youth, the sins of my age, the sins of my soul, the sins of my body, my idle sins, my serious voluntary sins, the sins I know, the sins I do not know; the sins I have concealed so long, and which are now hidden from my memory. I am truly sorry for every sin, mortal and venial, for all the sins of my childhood up to the present hour. I know my sins have wounded thy tender heart. O my Saviour, let me be freed from the bonds of evil through the most bitter passion of my Redeemer. Amen. O my Jesus, forget and forgive what I have been. Amen.' He then gives you Absolution and you may go in peace.

#### PRAYER FOR GOD'S HEALING

'Lord Jesus, I come before you just as I am with all my faults and failings and with all the wounds that I carry in my heart. I thank you that you gaze on me with complete and utter love. In a moment of silence I give to you my struggles and worries ... . Thank you Jesus that you care for my every need, please bless me with all the grace I need to cope with this day and to leave tomorrow in your hands. I pray for those who have hurt me today or in the past ... . I pray also for those whom I have hurt ... . Let your love flow freely in my heart to all those I meet this day. Mary, my mother, Queen of Peace, I pray that God's peace and healing love would fill my mind and heart. Amen.'
