The Church has seen this as Jesus showing us that as he was tempted before beginning his public ministry so we too should not be surprised if in turn we too are tempted and obstacles come our way whenever we set out to do God's will and follow Jesus. The devil leaves us alone if he sees we are not on the way to heaven but as soon as we set out to become followers of Jesus he will do all he can to stop us on the way. The way Our Lord deals with the temptations teaches us how to deal with them: Things alone cannot satisfy us but the Word of God can; Trust and have faith in God; and bow down not to the world but to God alone. With the Lord on our side we ought to have no fear. Have courage and God bless you this week, Fr Bruno.
