THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS

We are still hearing from our Lord's Sermon on the Mount today. There is a noticeable deepening though in the teaching which the people hear. BAPTISM CONGRATULATIONS

WORD STUDY: 'RIGHTEOUSNESS'

Dikaiosune (Gk): denotes the uprightness and faithfulness of God and his people. The word is part of a distinctive covenant vocabulary found throughout the Bible. It is used 7 times in Matthew and 85 times in the rest of the NT. (1) God's righteousness is characteristic of his being (holy) and revealed through his saving deeds and the care of Israel. God is righteous because he perfectly fulfils his covenant with Israel as a divine Father. The NT builds on this foundation: God now demonstrates his righteousness through the saving work of Jesus Christ. The New Covenant is ratified by Jesus' obedience to the Father and is proclaimed in the gospel. (2) For God's people, *righteousness* is a New Covenant gift from Christ. It is first given in Baptism and received by faith. It denotes one's restored relationship with God as an adopted son or daughter. This gift of righteousness can increase through love and obedience to God's covenant Law.

TIPS ON BECOMING A SAINT

We are called to forgive, not to keep grudges or resentments, to bless and not to curse: "Do not repay evil for evil or abuse for abuse; but on the contrary, repay with a blessing. It is for this that you were called – that you might inherit a blessing" (1 Peter 3:9). What do we do if we catch ourselves cursing others? ... The three 'R's'

- **1. Repent:** "Oh, Lord, there I go again. I'm sorry Lord. I repent of that reaction; I repent of the thoughts, the judgments, the anger, the words I uttered."
- **2. Revoke:** "I revoke all those negative, unkind thoughts, Lord. I un-think them, and I un-say those words."
- **3. Replace**: "I replace those 'curses' with a blessing, Lord. I forgive him/her, and I bless him/her, and I ask that you bless him/her, Lord." [V. Flynn, *7 Secrets of Confession*]
