MEDITATION - 'The Loaves that Lead to Understanding'

'Since the Eucharist is adherence to the person of Christ, then accepting Christ and clinging to him is fully expressed only when we partake in the Eucharist, which is the culmination of faith. During the Eucharist, Christ becomes the gift offered to the Father for our sake. Through the common royal priesthood, we also are called to give a complete offering of ourselves to God in union with Christ who offers himself to the Father. Our adherence to him means communion with his gift. It means giving our lives to God in order for them to be transformed and become a service to the Church and to our brothers. The purpose of the Eucharist is our conversion, our turning away from our own will so that it may gradually disappear in our service to others. We go to Holy Communion to be converted, to establish the reign of Christ in our hearts from then on, and for his will to become our supreme value. Every reception of the Eucharist should confirm our adherence to his will. Consequently, we should wish that Jesus would foil our plans. The Eucharist should prepare us for this; it should
